2. Prerequisites and postrequisites of the discipline

1. Prerequisites and postrequisites of the academic discipline

Prerequisites of the academic discipline. The study of the discipline "European integration reforms and decentralization" is based on the knowledge gained in the study of humanitarian and socio-economic disciplines, namely: "External policy of foreign countries."

Post-requisites of the academic discipline. The knowledge obtained by the applicant for higher education while studying the discipline "European integration reforms and decentralization" is mandatory for such components of further education: pre-diploma practice, qualifying thesis.

3. Characteristics of the discipline

As a result of studying the discipline, the student should receive: general competences:

- *ability to conduct research at the appropriate level.*
- ability to search, process and analyze information from various sources.
- *ability to learn and master modern knowledge.*
- ability to generate new ideas (creativity).
- *ability to communicate in a foreign language.*

professional competencies:

- awareness of the nature and importance of politics as a specific type of human activity and a special field of knowledge, including the development of ideas about politics and its modern interpretations.
- ability to carry out professional pedagogical and / or scientific and pedagogical activities in educational institutions.
- critical understanding of the problems and principles of functioning and patterns of development of government and public policy, political institutions and processes, gender policy, world policy and the policy of individual countries and regions.
- ability to comprehensively analyze power and governance, political systems, institutions and regimes, political processes and political behavior in different contexts of their functioning.
- ability to comprehensively use normative and empirical political theory, methodology of political research and applied political analysis.
- ability to use a wide range of concepts and methods to interpret and analyze policy at the local, national, European and global levels.
- ability to effectively perform political-organizational, expert-analytical and consulting functions at the national and international levels.

4. The purpose of studying the discipline

The purpose of teaching the discipline "European integration reforms and decentralization" is to form a system of knowledge and skills about the role of various government institutions in the process of application in the local self-government system in Ukraine in the context of decentralization of powers

5. Objectives of studying the discipline

- to familiarize students with modern approaches and concepts for the implementation of state policy in the field of local self-government;
- to provide students with knowledge on the theoretical, legal and organizational foundations of decentralization processes and institutional development of local self-government in Ukraine and foreign countries;
- to reveal the main features of a decentralized model of governance at the local level;
- to form students' skills in determining the main advantages / positive results, as well as problems and risks of decentralization of power at different levels of government;
- to form students' systematized knowledge about the basic organizational and legal mechanisms and management technologies at the local level;
- to form skills and abilities to ensure a balance of interests of self-government and state power at the local level in Ukraine, taking into account foreign experience;
- to form systematized knowledge about the factors of development of local self-government.

6. Content of the discipline

Content module I. European integration reforms Topic 1. European integration process.

Deeping EU-Ukraine relations. Provisions of the EU-Ukraine Association Agreement. Implementation of state policy in the field of European integration. The roadmap for the implementation of the Agreement with the EU by Ukraine. Institutional mechanisms for the implementation of state policy and the system of bilateral bodies of the Ukraine-EU association. Reformatting the European integration process: opportunities and risks.

Topic 2. Decentralization as the main direction of European integration reforms.

Basic aspects and problems of the concept of "decentralization's" modern understanding. The connection between decentralization and European integration. Development of decentralization processes in Ukraine in the conditions of the European integration action. European Union support to decentralization in Ukraine.

Topic 3. European Charter of Local Self-Government

The European Charter of Local Self-Government as a key reference point on the path of decentralization and reform of local self-government. Term "local authority". The Charter's provisions. The historical documents that can help to understand the essence of the Charter and the meaning of its terms. Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe. Ukraine and the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe.

Content module II. Decentralization and reform of local government. Topic 4. Decentralization as the main principle of local government reform.

Decentralization is a process for a result. Decentralization of power: essence and concept. Types and forms of decentralization. Legislative and regulatory framework for the implementation of state policy in the field of local self-government. Benefits and consequences of the decentralization of power.

Topic 5. Reform of decentralization in foreign countries: experience for Ukraine.

World models of decentralized governance. Sustainable development and effective municipal governance. Development of territorial cohesion. Decentralization and multilevel governance. Decentralization Trends in Ukraine and Foreign Countries: Comparative Analysis. Decentralization and Reintegration: Balancing Local and Regional Governance.

Topic 6. Local self-government reform in Ukraine.

Reform of local self-government and the system of territorial organization of power in Ukraine in the context of the implementation of the decentralization reform. Purpose, direction and mechanisms of effective self-government formation in Ukraine. Main factors that drive territorial communities to form amalgamated communities. The aspects of financial and fiscal decentralization.

Topic 7. Prospective directions of the development of territorial communities

New administrative and territorial arrangement of Ukraine. Distribution of powers between central, local executive authorities and local self-government bodies, as well as in the local self-government system. Characteristics of local self-government bodies powers of the basic, sub-regional, regional levels. Self-government in the areas temporarily not controlled by Ukrainian authorities. Amendments to the Constitution in the part of decentralization reform.

8. Independent work

Independent work is a type of mental activity in which a student independently (without outside help) processes a list of topics in each content module (based on the processing of information sources, he searches for answers to topical questions, solves practical questions, composes tests, solves a problem or situational exercise, performs other tasks based on knowledge gained from textbooks, books, lectures, practical exercises). The main goal of independent work is the formation of the independence of the subject, learns, the formation of his skills, knowledge and skills.

When studying the discipline "European integration reforms and decentralization", the following types of student self-study were identified:

- 1) working out the topics of lectures and seminars, performing practical work;
- 2) preparation of reports, presentation of the results of their own research and project;
- 3) preparation for modular control and exam;
- 4) work with information sources, etc.

Each of these types requires stubborn independent work from students. First of all, it is necessary that each student adheres to mental health during the learning process. The teacher of the discipline at the beginning of the study of the discipline conducts an orientation lesson, especially with students, they have drawn up an individual training schedule.

Independent work is carried out directly through the content and methods of all types of training sessions. Independent work of students is the main means of mastering the educational material in their free time from classroom studies. The study time allotted for independent work of students is regulated by the working curriculum.

Tasks for independent work should exclude the mechanical memorization of the actual material by students or superficial acquaintance with the phenomena and processes. To receive a positive assessment, a student must not only demonstrate possession of a certain amount of knowledge, but also be able to solve certain elements of scientific problems, analyze and systematize the data obtained, find original solutions based on independently obtained information, formulate and defend his own point of view. It is primarily about the independent study of educational, scientific and reference literature. A custom element of this work of students is keeping records (an electronic version or presentation is also allowed). This approach contributes to a better assimilation of the factual material, makes it possible to save it in a form convenient for use. The level of the student's performance of independent work is taken into account when setting the final grade by the content modules of the academic discipline.

Students have the opportunity to receive an assignment and upload their work to the distance learning system (moodle) of NU "Zaporizhzhya Polytechnic" (https://moodle.zp.edu.ua/).

10. Course policy

Classroom attendance policy (personal presence of the student).
