AGREEMENT

of Cooperation concluded on ______ between

Wrocław University of Science and Technology(Poland) and National University "Zaporizhzhia Polytechnic" (Ukraine)

The contracting parties agree to develop a co-operation in education and science that mutually benefits teaching staff, research workers and students of both universities.

The main purpose of this cooperation is to engage in joint scientific work.

[

In order to realise the aims mentioned above both Parties agree to carry out exchanges / mobility of:

- a) teaching staff, research workers and students (graduate and Phd) under conditions specified in the work-programmes of the co-operation, which will be prepared within the framework of this Agreement,
- b) scientific publications and results in the field of science,
- c) knowledge in the fields of education and training teaching staff and students, advancing teaching material and applying modern teaching methods.

Π

Both Parties agree to cooperate in research, to publish the results of joint scientific work, to cooperate in joint scientific projects and to implement the results of the scientific work in their institutes.

Ш

Both Parties will participate in scientific conferences, seminars and similar meetings which are organised by either Party, in the mutual exchanges of the lecturers as well as in joint programmes creation.

IV

Both Parties agree to prepare work programmes for every academic year that reflect the objectives of this Agreement.

V

The present Agreement does not exclude other forms of cooperation aimed at further development of relations between universities.

The Party shall not incur any obligations on behalf of the other Party, particularly of a financial or property nature, nor shall this Agreement constitute an authorization to take such actions. The Parties shall not make any claims against each other, including financial claims, in the event that the cooperation referred to in this Agreement fails to materialize.

VI

The Parties undertake to treat as confidential any information marked at the time of transfer as "confidential", not available to the public (in particular, information of a legal, financial, organizational, commercial, strategic nature including, but not limited to, documents, drawings,

etc.), which they obtain from the other Party in connection with the cooperation covered by this Agreement (hereinafter: "Confidential Information").

Each Party agrees not to use the Confidential Information for its own purposes other than those covered by this Agreement and not to transfer the Confidential Information to other parties without the prior written consent of the other Party. In particular, the Parties shall not rent, lease, lend or otherwise transfer Confidential Information received from the other Party.

VII

This Agreement is valid for a period of 5 years. It enters into effect from the date of its signing by the statutory representatives of both institutions. In case of a preterm cancellation of this Agreement the Party that intends to cancel the Agreement has to notify the other Party in writing no less than 6 months prior to the cancellation.

All modifications and additions to this Agreement are made in written form upon mutual consent of both Parties, otherwise null and void.

Coordination of cooperation is assigned on Prof. Valeriy Naumyk DSc, from Zaporizhzhia National Technical University and on prof. dr hab. Dariusz Łydźba, from Wrocław University of Science and Technology
