



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Faculty of Computer Science, Electrical Engineering and Information Technology of the UNIVERSITY OF STUTTGART, Keplerstr. 7, 70174 Stuttgart, Germany

## And

Faculty of Electrical Engineering of the NATIONAL UNIVERSITY ZAPORIZHZHIA POLYTECHNIC, Zhukovsky str. 64, 69063 Zaporizhzhia, Ukraine

"We, the undersigned parties, recognize the importance of international cooperation and collaboration in achieving our shared goals of advancing education, research, and social progress. We are committed to the fundamental values of academic freedom, accountability, equitable access, institutional autonomy, social responsibility and sustainability.

We enter into this agreement with a shared commitment to these values, and with the belief that our cooperation will enhance our ability to achieve our common goals.

The Faculty of Computer Science, Electrical Engineering and Information Technology of the University of Stuttgart, hereinafter referred to as USTUTT, and the Faculty of Electrical Engineering of the National University Zaporizhzhia Polytechnic, hereinafter referred to as NU Zaporizhzhia Polytechnic, in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between institutes of higher learning contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, agree to establish the following Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

This MoU will be the basis to promote the development of an agreement covering the following areas:

- Exchange of students
- Exchange of faculty and academic staff
- Instructional and cultural programs, including publication activities of mutual interest, exchange of bibliographic materials and shared access to information networks

1. Specific mechanisms for the implementation of particular cooperative and collaborative activities need to be established and described in writing by the responsible authority of each institution prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.

III

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this memorandum will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices, of each university as well as the law and regulations of each country.

- 1. This MoU is established for a period of three years, effective on the date of signing.
- In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, the Faculty of Computer Science, Electrical Engineering and Information Technology of USTUTT and the Faculty of Electrical Engineering of NU Zaporizhzhia Polytechnic agree to exchanging information, various formats for different modalities of cooperation and suggested plans for their implementation.
- 3. During the three-year period, this MoU is expected to be replaced by an Agreement for Academic Cooperation. The MoU can be canceled or prolonged by either party on a six month's notice. Prolongation should be agreed upon if a formal agreement has not yet been signed but is in progress.
