Abstract requirements:

Font: Times New Roman, size 14 pt, line spacing 1, margins 20 mm on all sides, paragraph indent 1,25 cm. If the text includes a table larger than one printed page, the page break should not be used.

References formatting should be done according to DSTU 8302:2015. In-text citations should be given in square brackets.

Length: 2-5 pages.

Publication languages: Ukrainian, English.

Number of authors – no more than 4.

The format of the conference is correspondence.

Cost of thesis publication in the **conference proceedings** is 100 UAH, cost of certificate is 50 UAH (15 hours – 0,5 ECTS credit). Payment details will be provided after the abstracts for publication acceptance.

The conference proceedings will be published within two months after the conference (in case of force majeure, the terms may be changed).
